1. Answer questions about Caucus
 - Pre-registration process: will need voter ID # - can find on vote.utah.gov; register using state party's caucus website - receive credential for caucus via text/email (green = verified registered republican; yellow = unaffiliated needing to affiliate, or provide proof of private republican registration; red = registered with another party, not eligible to participate at caucus); show state ID & credential at caucus check in; all precincts sharing the building can credential together
 - Geoff made flowchart for check in/help desk volunteers
 - Contact cities to put caucus info in their newsletters; Bonnie G. & Valerie already contacted Providence, but it is too late for Feb & Mar newsletters - the city will share on social media though
 - Logan High is booked with school events for April, JoAnn will check with Green Canyon for County Convention
2. Answer questions about Lincoln Dinner - cachegop.com/lincoln
 - a. Printing table placards - Geoff created/Pam will print - color/cardstock
 - b. Printing program & straw poll - Pam print
 - c. Straw poll administration - straw poll will be conducted as vote for one candidate per category, not separated by districts/races (US Senate, US House, Governor, Attorney General, Utah Legislature, County Council, County Clerk, County Auditor, County Attorney)
 - d. Open house management - booths will have papers w/names so candidates will know where to setup; booths will be in the International Lounge; speeches will be in the Big Blue Room; need someone to help direct people; seating charts for both booths & tables for dinner
