Official Request for Bylaw 9 G revision and disclosure be attached to County Office Declaration of Candidacy filing form to promote election transparency and fair notice to all Republican candidates.

Presentation for a vote at the next CCC meeting

(9G)A candidate for a county, state legislature or state school board office who filed an official Declaration of Candidacy by selecting one of the 3 county/ state choices, shall receive a full written disclosure in detail of each filing method and require a signed confirmation showing the candidate received and reviewed the disclosure. Change is acceptable within 7 days.

Convention Only: Is eligible to receive, but not limited to the following: Full Republican party benefits such as campaign literature distribution, town halls, debates etc, use of GOP media for promotional information, and will receive the precinct officer/delegate list from the most current Caucus.

Signature Gathering Only : Is not eligible to receive any recognition as a candidate or assistance in any form from the Republican party until after the primary election, unless required by law. Signature gathering candidates are always listed on ballots after non-signature gathering candidates.

Both Convention & Signature Gathering: Candidates are eligible to receive full Republican benefits as listed above, but only until the official Cache Valley Convention. If they do not receive the required 30% vote, they will receive no further help, until after the Primary.

*This document must fully explain the procedural requirements, compliance obligations and official deadlines associated with the chosen filing method and the candidate must sign an acknowledgment of receipt.
